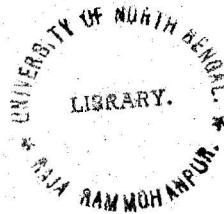

## PREFACE

RECENT developments in the constitutional evolution of the British Empire have rendered it desirable that there should be issued a list of publications on this question, additional to those contained in the bibliography published by the Royal Empire Society in January 1926.

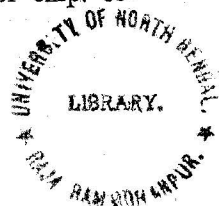
